Dear Valued Customer,

Thank you for your recent reservation with Huzzah Valley Resort. For 32 years Huzzah Valley Resort has been recognized as a quality recreational resort. We have made a continuous effort to provide a safe and enjoyable atmosphere for all of our customers. In order to continue to provide such services, the management and Staff of Huzzah Valley Resort have implemented the following practices and procedures.

- ✦ **DRIVERS LICENSE:** Everyone in the party, staying on the Loud Side must be 18 years of age. Everyone will be asked to show a valid driver's license upon check in. At which time a copy of the driver's license will be made for reference in the reservation.
 - If someone in your party is under 18 they must have a parental form signed by their parents upon arrival or they will not be able to stay in the loud area.

- ✦ **POSSESSION OF ILLEGAL DRUGS OR FIREARMS:** There will be no illegal drugs or firearms allowed in the campground or on Huzzah Valley premises, or on the Huzzah River. Those who possess these items will be prosecuted to the full extent of the law and the ENTIRE group will be escorted from the grounds, forfeiting any money paid. Anyone affiliated with Huzzah Valley Resort, who suspects that someone has these items in their possession has been instructed to report their suspicions to management and the local authorities.
- ✦ **PATROLS:** Management has requested that local law enforcement officials, including Missouri State Highway Patrol, Missouri State Water Patrol, and the Crawford County Sheriff's Department to make periodic drives through the campground to check for suspicious behavior.
- ✦ **FIGHTING AND OBNOXIOUS BEHAVIOR WILL NOT** be tolerated within the premises of Huzzah Valley nor on the Huzzah River. Violators will be prosecuted to the full extent of the law and the ENTIRE group will be requested to leave the grounds, forfeiting all money paid.
- ✦ **APPROPRIATE BUS BEHAVIOR.** Anyone using any excessive foul language or displaying obnoxious behavior, including fighting, on the bus or beach going to, or returning from, will forfeit all money paid for unused services.

- ✿ **ABUSE OF THE CAMPGROUND AND/OR HUZAZH VALLEY PREMISES AND ITS POSSESSIONS:** Anyone who abuses the campgrounds or premises will be escorted from the campground, forfeiting all money paid. In addition, a monetary value will be assigned to the destroyed property, and those responsible for the damage will be liable for this sum. This abuse includes: destruction or marring of trees; destruction of grounds, including but not limited to, damaging or destroying of boating equipment; damaging and destroying camping equipment, such as picnic tables, grills, and fire rings and leaving excess trash in the campground.
- ✿ **LOUD AREA/FAMILY AREA:** Anyone staying in the loud area will not be allowed to drive through or visit anyone in the family area and anyone in the family area will not be allowed to drive through or visit anyone in the loud area. This helps our security keep things secure.
- ✿ **EXCESSIVE NOISE POLICY:** Huzzah Valley has implemented the quiet hours of 2:00 am. This excessive noise policy begins at 12:00 am. All loud noises, including those of radios, must be quieted down beginning at 12:00 am. At 2:00 am. All noise must cease. Violators of this policy will be escorted from Huzzah Valley premises, forfeiting all money paid for unused services.
- ✿ **VEHICLE REQUIREMENTS:** All vehicles are required to register at the Country Store. The License plate number of the vehicle is required. Once registration is completed and while staying in the campground, each vehicle must remain parked at the respective campsite unless it is traveling between justifiable destinations. Parking on the river bank is not permitted at any time. Those not complying will be escorted from Huzzah Valley premises, forfeiting all money paid.
- ✿ **NO KEGS:** are allowed on the river: **NO EXCEPTIONS!!**

Please note that as group leader, you are responsible for the behavior of those in the group. The behavior of a few can ruin the vacation for the entire group. It is your responsibility to ensure that everyone in your group has a good time, but behaves in a responsible and respectable manner. Management reserves the right to evict any or your entire group for non-compliance with the above regulations. Any problems that you incur with another group, you must report immediately to the security team at Huzzah Valley.

The management and staff at Huzzah Valley Resort appreciate your business. We hope that by implementing these standards, we can continue to provide a safe and fun environment for your camping vacation.
